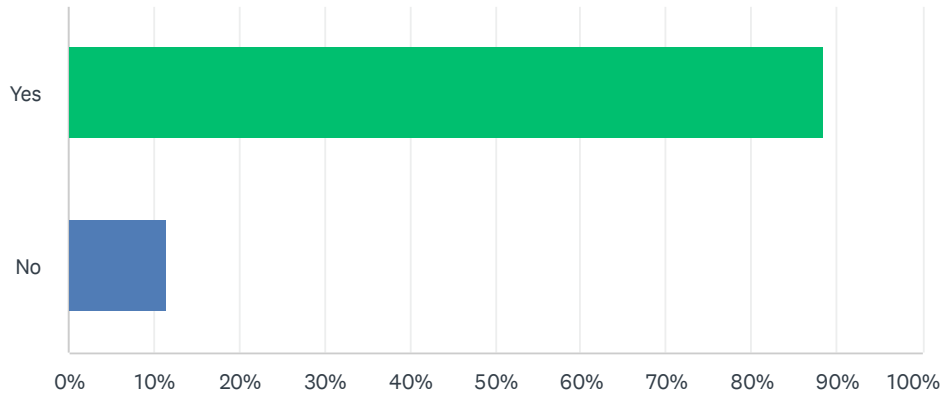


Q1 Are you a resident of Indiana Borough, Pennsylvania?

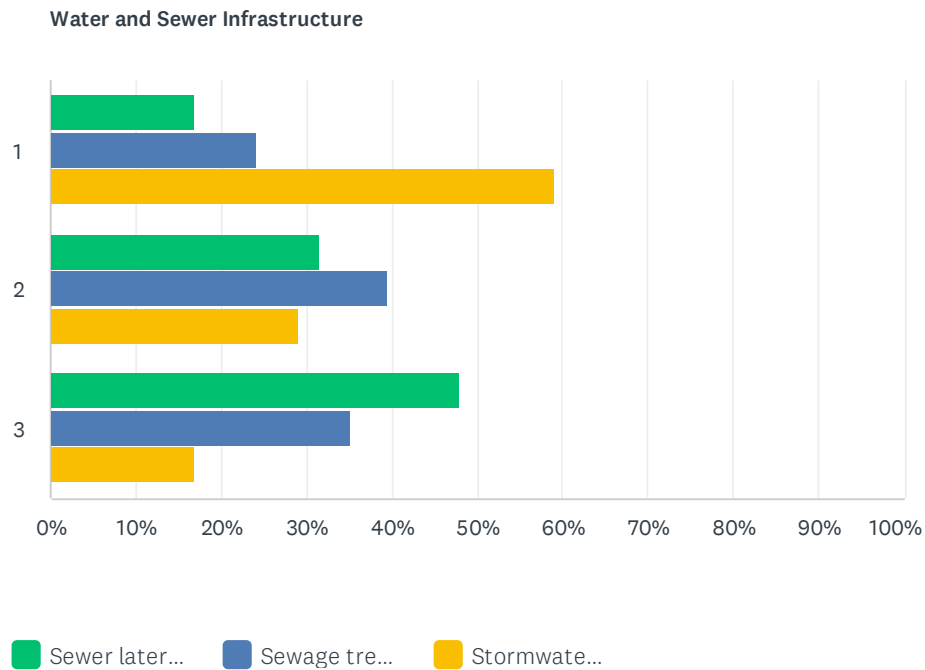

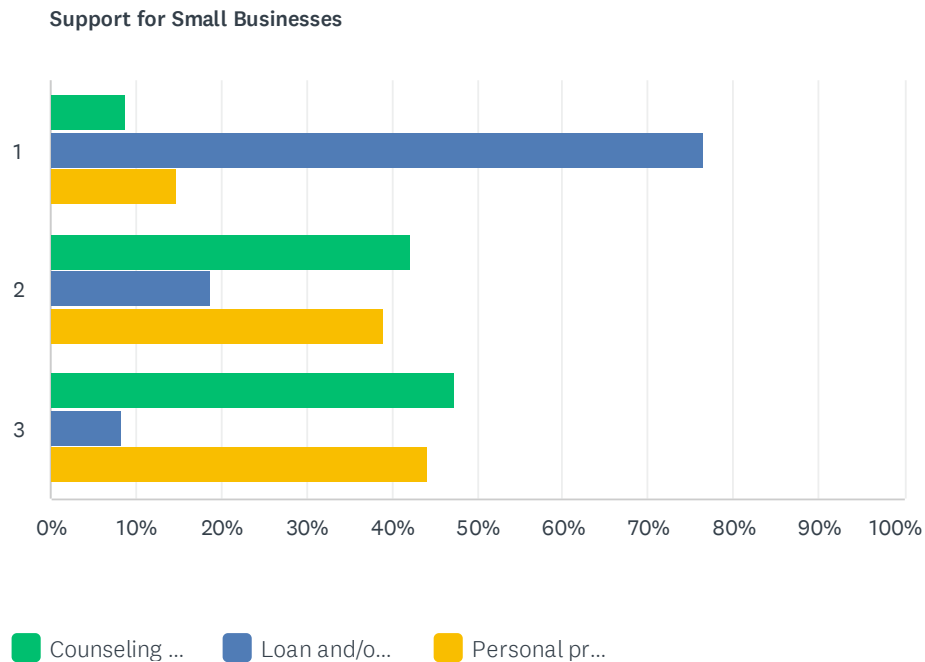

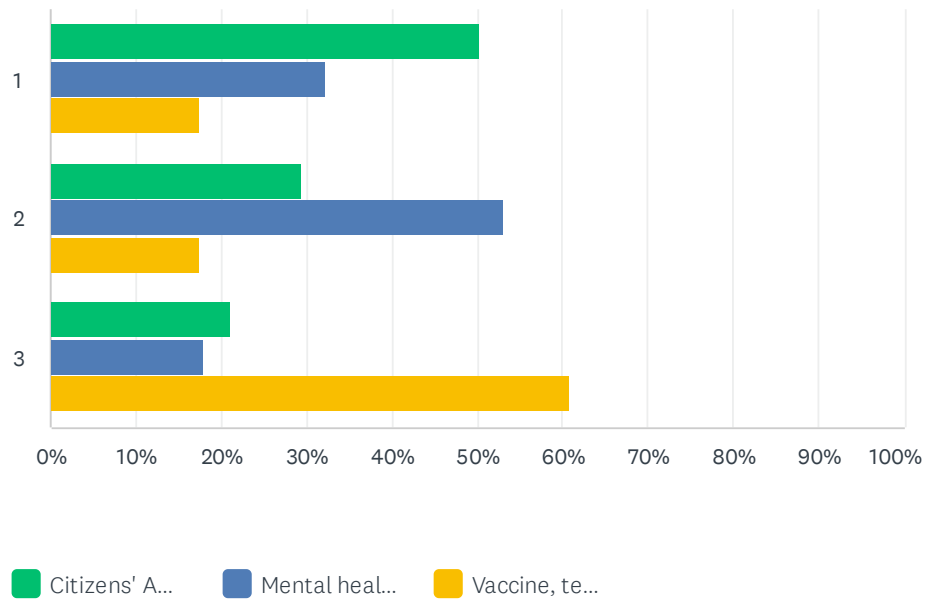

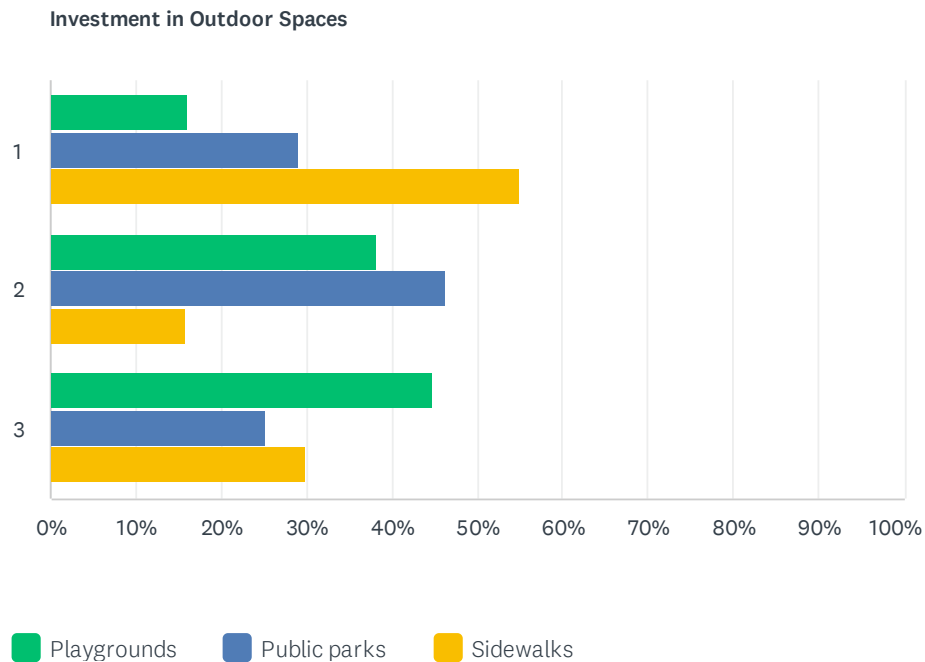
